At its heart is an innovative eco-village where you'll be enveloped by the stunning forests as you celebrate your special day outdoors with family and friends.

As soon as you head off the meandering back roads of the Huon Valley and venture up into the forested hills surrounding Huon Bush Retreats you'll know you have found somewhere truly inspiring to begin your new life. A secluded honeymoon suite means there is room for everyone and you can relax knowing your guests are safe with all other cabins in walking distance from the entertainment area.

Huon Bush Retreats can cater for up to 50 guests.

About Us

Mt Misery Habitat Reserve is a loose community conservation effort, where many neighbours have co-operatively protected some eight square kilometers (1,600 acres) of private land plus the intervening public lands.

Many of the properties (including Huon Bush Retreats) are protected in perpetuity by conservation covenants. Covenants are attached to the title and the conditions apply to all future owners. Most of the covenants in this area allow people to use 20% of each title, leaving 80% protected for nature.

Part of the reserve, southwest from the summit, is owned by Huon Nature Trust and leased by Huon Bush Retreats.

Huon Nature Trust exists to commercially support the aims and protection of Mt Misery Habitat Reserve. Environmentally minded people have pooled money into the trust to achieve protection of natural values.

The unit trust owns the land, cabins and infrastructure, with the principal goal of protecting the land and natural values at Mt Misery. It is an arrangement where ethical investment meets private conservation. The Trust then leases the land and cabins to Huon Bush Retreats.

About half of the available units have been sold so far. As units are sold, more cabins can be built, up to the maximum of eight. After that, we hope to purchase surrounding land to better protect the core values of Mt Misery Habitat Reserve.
